AP, IBDP & UIC Credit Awarding Policy

Advanced Placement (AP) and IBDP(International Baccalaureate Diploma Program) credits that students earned before college matriculation may be used to satisfy degree requirements. Up to 10 credits total may be granted from AP and .IBDP classes, from exploratory classes, or other credit awards.

- A maximum of 9 credits from AP examinations, IBDP subjects may be counted toward degree requirements.
- · A maximum of 6 credits from AP examinations, IBDP subjects may be counted toward major requirements.
- AP examinations, IBDP subjects credit cannot be used to fulfill Common Curriculum requirements except Science Literacy requirement (MAT, PHY, CHE, BIO).
