## VIII. Student Visa & Insurance

### STUDENT VISA FOR INTERNATIONAL FRESHMEN

All international students should obtain **D-2 (student) visa**(exception: F-4 Visa). Visa status, study programs and related information should be submitted to Foreign Student Information System run by Ministry of Justice. Please obtain a student visa before the start of the semester. International students in need of the Certificate of Admission may contact the admissions officer of UIC.

### IMMIGRATION

#### A. ALIEN REGISTRATION CARD

Foreigners staying in Korea for more than 90 days must register for an Alien Registration Card(ARC) at a local immigration office within 90 days from the date of entry. Simply receiving your visa is not the last step to registration, and those with visas must receive an ARC to finalize their sojourn documentation. It is illegal to stay in Korea for more than 90 days without being registered, regardless of your visa at entry. Please be sure to check for the most recent information at (<http://hikorea.go.kr>) before your visit, or by calling the immigration hotline at 1345 (no area code needed).

### B. ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE THE SCOPE OF STUDENT VISA

International students holding a D-2 visa should get an approval from the immigration office if they plan to work part-time. Undergraduate students can work up to 25 hours per week according to their proficiency in Korean language and they should obtain the confirmation on their application form from Office of International Affairs, then finally submit the application form to Immigration Office.

### C. LEAVE OF ABSENCE

<b>Taking a leave of absence</b>	International students who wish to go on a leave of absence must leave the country within 30 days after applying and turn in their Alien Registration Card to immigration at the airport.
<b>Returning from a leave of absence</b>	In order to return to school, students need to apply online via the Yonsei Portal during the application period for reinstatement. Students will need a new student visa and must submit all required documents to the Office of International Affairs. Therefore, students should contact the office of International Affairs at <a href="mailto:ivisa@yonsei.ac.kr">ivisa@yonsei.ac.kr</a> after making an application for returning through the Yonsei Portal.

### E. HEALTH INSURANCE (INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)

- The national health insurance (NHI) system is one of the social insurance schemes that provides benefits for the prevention, diagnosis, treatment etc. of possible diseases and injuries for the purpose of improving citizens' health and promoting social security.
- Students holding D-2 Visa are to subscribe NHI on the date of Alien Registration.
- Benefits are equal with those of Korean citizens.
  - NHI subscribers are required to make a partial payment at the point of receiving services, and the National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) will pay the rest to the providers.
- NHI contribution notification
  - A monthly contribution is sent via post or e-mail on 15<sup>th</sup> of each month.
  - (In-person payment) Visit a bank with the bill
  - (contact-free) Mobile, website, virtual account, automatic transfer
  - Payment due date: the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- **Caution:** If an international student fails to pay the contributions, Visa extension can be limited.
